Abstrak

Fiscal decentralization enters into poverty alleviation strategy in a number of ways. The proximity of policy makers to the target groups reduces information and transaction costs of indentifying the poor and helps in designing potentially successful capacity improving and safety net policies. The main purpose of this research is to reveal how the effects of government expenditure on poverty alleviation through dynamic interactions between economic growth and income inequality. The public spending on education and health is concentered to be appropriate policies for pro-poor, while the public expenditure for health sector significantly effected on all, poverty indicators, such as poverty, headcount, poverty gap dan poverty severity.
