Studi ini bertujuan untuk mempelajari pengaruh keterlibatan suami terhadap pemanfaatan penolong persalinan tenaga kesehatan menggunakan data 6.425 wanita usia subur berusia 15-49 tahun yang menikah/hidup bersama dan mempunyai anak yang lahir terakhir dalam masa survei SDKI 2012. Hasil regresi logistik biner menunjukkan bahwa keterlibatan suami memiliki pengaruh signifikan terhadap pemanfaatan penolong persalinan tenaga kesehatan. Ditemukan pula bahwa faktor-faktor terkuat yang mempengaruhi pemanfaatan penolong persalinan tenaga kesehatan adalah tempat tinggal, pendidikan suami, dan kehadiran suami saat antenatal care. Salah satu variabel yang menunjukkan akses, yaitu jarak ke fasilitas kesehatan, juga memiliki pengaruh yang signifikan terhadap pemanfaatan penolong persalinan.
