Cakupan pemberian ASI eksklusif di Indonesia dan di Kota Jambi masih rendah, meskipun pemerintah sudah mencanangkan ASI eksklusif sejak tahun 2010 tentang standar minimum untuk ASI 80%. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui hubungan dukungan keluarga dengan pemberian ASI eksklusif pada bayi di Kota Jambi. Desain penelitian yang digunakan adalah deskriptif korelasi dengan pendekatan cross sectional. Sampel penelitian merupakan ibu yang mempunyai bayi umur 0-6 bulan sebanyak 70 orang yang diambil secara Cluster sampling. Hasil analisis data penelitianmenunjukkan bahwa ada hubungan yang signifikan antara dukungan informasi, dukungan instrumental, dukungan emosional dan dukungan penghargaan dengan pemberian ASI eksklusif pada bayi, sedangkan dukungan keluarga yang dominan adalah dukungan instrumental.
