Abstrak

Given the size of China and its global importance, the book then review s China?s current energy situation and fills the gaps in the literature for those who are interested in and concerned about China?s economic development and energy reform in the new millennium.

The book is different from previous studies in several important ways. Firstly, it presents recent, pioneering research rather than a simple textbook, several sections of which have been published in high-quality energy journals.
