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Abstrak

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Selama ini, negara kita terpengaruh oleh budaya patriarki yang menempatkan laki-laki

sebagai sosok yang lebih dominan. Namun ternyata, ada fenomena yang menunjukkan sebaliknya. Hal ini dapat dilihat dari kemunculan dua geng motor perempuan yaitu Geng Nero dan Geng CMP. Kemunculan dua geng tersebut merupakan bentuk pembuktian bahwa perempuan juga ingin disetarakan dengan laki-laki. Kedua geng tersebut sering melakukan aksi kekerasan demi mempertahankan groupthink syndrome mereka sebagai geng motor perempuan yang memiliki kekuatan.
