Penelitian ini meneliti tentang persepsi dan kebutuhan bahasa Inggris mengenai Bahasa Inggris untuk Tujuan

Khusus pada siswa kelas 11 SMA Negeri 116 Ragunan. Hal ini dikarenakan para siswa di sekolah tersebut adalah atlet profesional remaja. Perbedaan kebutuhan bahasa Inggris dengan rata-rata siswa SMA lain menjadikan penelitian ini signifikan. SMA Negeri 116 Ragunan memberlakukan kurikulum terbaru di Indonesia, Kurikulum 2013, yang bisa dikombinasikan dengan tujuan khusus para siswa. Metode yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah deskriptif kuantitatif, menggunakan kuesioner tertutup dan wawancara. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa persepsi bahasa Inggris para siswa masih rendah di empat aspek (mendengar, membaca, menulis, dan berbicara), namun yang terendah adalah kecakapan berbicara. Penting bagi para guru untuk mempersiapkan siswanya dengan kecakapan yang paling mereka butuhkan dan memenuhi perubahan kurikulum di Indonesia.
