

Perubahan fonologis kata serapan bahasa Indonesia yang berasal dari bahasa Belanda dalam majalah Cultural edisi 001 periode Januari-Februari 2011 = Phonological change of loanwords that came from Dutch in Cultural magazine edition 001 January-February 2011

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Abstrak

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Kedatangan bangsa Belanda ke Indonesia selama kurang lebih 3,5 abad tentu mengakibatkan beberapa hal. Kontak bahasa yang terjadi antar kedua bangsa tersebut pun tidak dapat dihindarkan. Kontak bahasa tersebut mengakibatkan munculnya kata serapan, yang hingga kini masih sering digunakan dalam kehidupan sehari-hari.

Dalam penyerapan suatu kata tentu sudah mengalami beberapa perubahan dan penyesuaian kedalam kaidah bahasa penerima, salah satunya adalah perubahan dan penyesuaian sistem fonologis. Penelitian ini berfokus pada perubahan sistem fonologis kata serapan bahasa Belanda kedalam bahasa Indonesia pada Majalah Cultural edisi 001 tahun 2011.

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ABSTRACT

The arrival of the Dutch in Indonesia has lasted for approximately 3.5 centuries would lead to several things. Language contact that occurs between the two nations was unavoidable. The language contact resulted in the emergence of a loan word, which is still frequently used in daily life. In the absorption of a word would have undergone several changes and adjustments into the recipient language rules, one of which is the change and adjustment of the phonological system. This study focuses on changes in the phonological system of a loan word from Dutch into Indonesian language on Cultural Magazine 1st in 2011.

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
