Abstrak

Majority of health service rooms available at health centers were generally clinics (inpatients = 97.4%, outpatient = 95.8%), whereas the most eligible was dental clinics. The eligible of service rooms, majority in the common areas (64.5-85.5%) than remote (25.3-66%) or very remote areas (24-56.6%), in non-island areas (37.2%), than in island areas (29.3-67.5%) and in non-neighboring areas (36.8-81.5%) compared to the neighboring areas, in area with population of >30.000 people (45.3-90.4%) compared to <30.000 people (31.6-74.6%) and urban (46.6-89.3%) than in rural areas (33.2-79%). There were significant associations between eligibility of health service related to topography, demography, and geography.
