

Perbandingan efek penggunaan video dan audio dalam pengajaran kemahiran menyimak ceramah = A comparison of video and audio text effects on listening to lecture classes / Harumi Manik Ayu Yamin

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Abstrak

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Tesis ini membahas perbandingan efek penggunaan video dan audio dalam pengajaran kemahiran ceramah untuk mahasiswa Program Studi Inggris. Penelitian ini adalah penelitian kombinasi kuantitatif dan kualitatif dengan desain penelitian eksperimental. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa tidak ada perbedaan signifikan antara hasil tes kemahiran menyimak kelas yang diajar dengan video dan hasil tes kemahiran menyimak kelas yang diajar dengan audio. Penggunaan video juga terbukti tidak memiliki efek yang signifikan terhadap hasil tes murid yang memiliki gaya pembelajaran visual. Walau demikian, hasil kuesioner dan wawancara membuktikan motivasi dan kepercayaan murid yang tinggi terhadap penggunaan video sehingga peneliti merekomendasikan penggunaan video dan audio sebagai media ajar.
