Marine fishery resources in Malaysia have declined considerably over the past decades, primarily due to overfishing. Excessive fishing has also damaged marine habitats, a serious concern for the Malaysian government. To conserve and enhance natural fish stocks in various locations in marine waters, the government introduced the use of artificial reefs (ARs). ARs are expected to rehabilitate degraded fish stocks and secure the livelihood of the fishers along coastal villages.
