Penelitian ini mencoba untuk memetakan kondisi perfilman Indonesia dalam konteks pasar film dunia dan mengidentifikasi kebijakan pemerintah yang tepat sasaran. Satu pijakan penting dalam penelitian ini adalah mempelajari pola penjualan film Indonesia melalui partisipasi aktif di festival film internasional. Berdasarkan penelitian, ditemukan bahwa peran pemerintah sangatlah penting dalam upaya mengembangkan film indonesia di tingkat dunia, terutama melalui program penguatan daya saing yang berkesinambungan. This research departs from studying sales patterns of Indonesian films through participation in international film festivals. The research outcome demonstrates that government policies may play a significant role in internationalizing Indonesian films through various programs to support its sustainable competitiveness. The research is based on qualitative interpretative methods in obtaining information and insights from both domestic and international film industry stakeholders as well as various government policymakers involved in the Indonesian film sector. The outcome of this research is expected to contribute in formulating policy strategies related to support the sustainable internationalization of Indonesian films.
