This research describes the depiction of Bodhisattwa's relief in North and South Main Temples of Plaosan Lor. The purpose of this research is to figure out the iconography of Bodhisattwa's reliefs in Main Temple of Plaosan Lor. Based on a description and comparison method, this research describes the result of the depiction of Bodhisattwa's iconography in North and South Main Temples of Plaosan Lor. The depiction of Bodhisattwa's relief in Plaosan Lor has a special style because they have same iconography, but still has different style depiction in every frames. The explanation of Bodhisattwa's reliefs on main temples of Plaosan Lor will also show the artist silpin role in every depiction of Bodhisattwa's reliefs and role of Bodhisattwa's reliefs in the holy buildings, this research will also show the walking direction in the temple's ritual procession, meditation point, and the concept of Catur Arya Saccani and Astavidha in Mahayana Buddhism.
