The result of this research is there are two different factors that effect to women for involving to terror groups such as internal and external factors. Moreover, there are variation of women's role in terror groups such as sympathizers, collecting funding, training to be combatant even to be the actor of suicide bombing. The emergence of Dian Yulia Novi as the first woman who wanted to be suicide bomber, showing that the role of Indonesian women in terrorism groups has increased because women intend to carry out suicide bombings based on orders from their husbands.
