Abstrak

Asia-Pacific as the “pivot” of the 21st century area, related to the various issues that became the main agenda when discussing the development of international politics today. The dynamics of major-power relations as the complexity of the USA-China relations has effected significantly to the regional order in Asia Pacific has a “hidden” agenda when China as an emerging power presenting a threat towards US hegemony existence in the region.
