

The impact of university's mission, curriculum, and leadership toward students' view of anti-radicalism

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Abstrak

The spread-out of radicalism and terrorism needs to be overcome in the very early stage at home, school, university, and community. For that, education institutions should build anti-radicalism attitude for its students through an integrated values of characterbuilding. This study aims to analyze the impact of university's mission, curriculum, and leadership towards student's attitude of anti-radicalism. The study is undertaken with a quantitative approach by using a multiple regression analysis, in universities implementing ahlusunnah wal jama'ah principles, nationalism, and insight of nationality. The study found that factors such as leadership, curriculum, and mission significantly have positive impact and big contribution toward student's anti-radicalism attitude.
