

# **Hubungan Tingkat Terpaan Disorder Policing dengan Tingkat Fear of Crime Warga Kecamatan Tebet Kota Jakarta Selatan = The Relationship between the Level of Exposure to Disorder Policing and the Level of Fear of Crime in Residents of Tebet District, South Jakarta City**

## **Abstrak**

Sejumlah penelitian telah menganalisis hubungan antara disorder dan fear of crime, tetapi hanya sedikit yang berfokus pada hubungan antara disorder policing dan fear of crime. Skripsi ini melakukan analisis terhadap hubungan antara tingkat disorder policing dengan tingkat fear of crime warga Kecamatan Tebet Kota Jakarta Selatan dengan metode penelitian kuantitatif melalui survei menggunakan kuesioner. Temuan penelitian menunjukkan bahwa terdapat hubungan antara tingkat disorder policing dengan tingkat fear of crime yang bersifat negatif. Selain itu, penelitian juga menemukan bahwa dua pendekatan pemolisian yang memiliki hubungan dengan tingkat fear of crime adalah pendekatan problem-oriented disorder policing dan community-oriented disorder policing. Sementara itu, pendekatan zero-tolerance disorder policing tidak berhubungan dengan tingkat fear of crime. Oleh sebab itu, temuan penelitian menyarankan bahwa implementasi disorder policing harus disesuaikan dengan kawasan maupun elemen masyarakat yang terlibat.

.....A number of studies have analyzed the relationship between disorder and fear of crime, but only a few have focused on the relationship between disorder policing and fear of crime. This thesis analyzes the relationship between the level of disorder policing and the level of fear of crime among residents of Tebet District, South Jakarta City using quantitative research methods through a survey design using a questionnaire. Research findings show that there is a negative relationship between the level of disorder policing and the level of fear of crime. The research also found that two policing approaches that are related to the level of fear of crime are problem-oriented disorder policing and community-oriented disorder policing. Meanwhile, the zero-tolerance disorder policing approach is not related to the level of fear of crime. Therefore, research findings suggest that the implementation of disorder policing must be adapted to the area and elements of society involved.
