

Hubungan Sikap dan Efikasi Diri Perawat dengan Pelaksanaan Spiritual Care di Ruang Rawat Inap dan Ruangan Khusus RSUD Undata Palu = The Relationship between Nurses' Attitudes and Self-Efficacy with The Implementation of Spiritual Care in Inpatient Rooms and Special Rooms RSUD Undata Palu

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Abstrak

Pelaksanaan spiritual care merupakan bagian penting dalam asuhan keperawatan holistik yang mencakup aspek bio-psiko-sosio-spiritual. Spiritual care bertujuan untuk mengurangi kecemasan, memberi ketenangan, menambah motivasi serta mempercepat kesembuhan pasien. Sikap dapat mempengaruhi perilaku dan kinerja perawat, efikasi diri mempengaruhi kepercayaan diri perawat dan kinerja perawat. Penelitian ini bertujuan mengidentifikasi hubungan sikap dan efikasi diri perawat dengan pelaksanaan spiritual care di ruang rawat inap dan ruangan khusus RSUD Undata. Desain penelitian menggunakan pendekatan cross-sectional dengan sampel 201 responden yang dipilih secara simple random sampling. Alat ukur yang digunakan mengukur sikap adalah Spirituality and Spiritual Care Rating Scale (SSCRS) cronbach's Alpha 0,752, General self efficacy scale untuk mengukur efikasi diri dengan cronbach's Alpha 0,782 kuesioner Nurse Spiritual Care Therapeutics Scale (NSCTS) cronbach's Alpha 0,764. Hasil uji mann whitney menunjukkan terdapat hubungan signifikan antara sikap dan efikasi diri pelaksanaan spiritual care ($p < 0,05$). Penelitian ini merekomendasikan untuk memfasilitasi perawat melalui pelatihan untuk dapat meningkatkan kesadaran dan kemampuan dalam pelaksanaan spiritual care.

.....The implementation of spiritual care is an important part of holistic care that includes bio-psychosocio-spiritual aspects. Spiritual care aims to reduce anxiety, provide peace, increase motivation and accelerate patient recovery. Attitudes can affect the behavior and performance of nurses, self-efficacy affects nurses' self-confidence and nurse performance. This study aims to identify the relationship between attitudes and self-efficacy of nurses with the implementation of spiritual care in inpatient rooms and special rooms at Undata Hospital. The study design used a cross-sectional approach with a sample of 201 respondents selected by simple random sampling. The measuring instrument used to measure attitudes was the Spirituality and Spiritual Care Rating Scale (SSCRS) Cronbach's Alpha 0.752, General self-efficacy scale to measure self-efficacy with Cronbach's Alpha 0.782 Nurse Spiritual Care Therapeutics Scale (NSCTS) questionnaire Cronbach's Alpha 0.764. The results of the Mann Whitney test showed a significant relationship between attitudes and self-efficacy in the implementation of spiritual care ($p < 0.05$). This study recommends facilitating nurses through training to increase awareness and ability in implementing spiritual care.
