Abstrak

his book questions the logic and basis of the comparisons between Islamic and Western values and cultures in todays public discourse in the West. The book calls attention to inadequacies in discussions about Islam and modernity, violence in Islamic law and history, the common image of everyday life in Muslim societies, and respect for individuals' privacy in Islamic cultures. The book specifically addresses the question of the autonomy of the individual and implicit and explicit rights under Islamic law, the questions of the laws of war and the laws of apostasy in Islam, and the right to privacy.
